Transportation links to the area are excellent.

The airport is located on the site of the former Royal Air Force base Pembrey, and is positioned on a scenic coastal plain. It offers easy access to those who visit by plane or by car and is the perfect gateway to both South and West Wales. With road links in the surrounding areas recently upgraded, access is available to the main tourist resorts, industrial and business centres of South and West Wales.

The main London to Fishguard railway runs through the Pembrey Peninsular passing only 900 metres from Pembrey Airport boundary. This line connects London with the West Wales port from which the ferry sails to Cork in Ireland. The nearby M4 motorway provides excellent road access to Swansea, Cardiff and the east. A bus service runs every twenty minutes.


Ffoslas Racecourse
